MgO Primer has been specially designed to negate the high absorption and super smooth surface of MgO board. When using Spacetherm WL, Primer can be used, dependant on the requirements of the user; to remove the suction for the board, preparing it for decoration, other than plaster finish. It is a technically advanced, high performance product which does not need mixing and can be applied in one coat. MgO Primer dries quickly dependant on climatic conditions, allowing the user fast progression to the next stage. For plaster finishes, please see Plasterbond datasheet

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

All surfaces must be clean, sound and free from dirt, grease and other contaminants.

MgO Primer should be applied to Spacetherm WL using a brush, fine roller or sprayed on. Ensure that the whole surface is covered and wait to dry before preparing for decoration, other than plaster finish. Application of the next layer should always be carried out following the specific manufacturer's instructions.

MgO Primer does not need shaking or stirring and is supplied in a 5L ready to use container.

Do not dilute.
